## 13 DAIRIES RANK OVER 95 PER CENT

Tests Made by City Bureau Under Direction of Federal and College Experts.

97 ARE UP TO 90 PER CENT

Analyses Made of Milk Gathered by Inspectors in December From Dairymen on Their Routes and All Contents Are Considered.

Thirteen dairies delivering raw dairy milk in Furtland got ratings between 95 and 100 in the recent milk contest conducted by the city milk inspection bureau under the direction of P. H. Bothel, of the United States Bureau of agriculture and the Agricultural College, according to the ratings made public yesterday. Eignty-four dairies ated between 20 and 85, 14 rated beween \$5 and \$6, three between \$6 and one between T5 and By and three between 40 and 70. The ratings, which were made on the basis of quality of milk being delivered, were based on

milk being delivered, were based to 100 points.

Of the unnerms delivering raw dairy milk from depots it received ratings between 95 and 96, one between 90 and 85 and one between 90 and 85 and encountries concerns four were rated between 10d and 10, nine between 95 and 90, four between 95 and 85 and one between 80 and 10. Both of the city's certified plants rated between 100 and

The contest was conducted in De-cember. Milk inspectors gathered sam-ples from the dalrymen on their routes and the samples were analysed in the city milk laboratories by chemists em-plored by the city, the Agricultural College and the Federal Government. Hatings were based upon the purity of the milk as determined by the bacterial round, the butter fat, solids—net fat, flavor, oder, package and cleanliness. 


