

**BATHING SUITS QUIT 3 INCHES FROM HIPS**

Bare Legs and Arms and Decollete Neck, Skin-Tight Jersey New Mode.

**WAIST LINE IS ELEVATED**

Soft, Flowing Lines, Draped Effects, Old-Fashioned Flashes, Falling Laces, Ruffles, Etc., Are Favored in Spring Styles.

CHICAGO, Feb. 8.—(Special.)—Bathing beach policemen may take nervous reaction this summer by keeping bathing suits within the limits of the law as to measurements.

"Three inches above the knee" is supposed to be the official edict, but the beach tape measure will have to be declared to make it behave, for bathing suits that were shown at the Fashion Show at the Auditorium are not more than three inches below the hip.

"Another thing is the adoption of the Jersey. This means a skin-tight garment, with a little skirt as a concession. But bare legs, no sleeves and a decollete neck accompany the Jersey.

There was a stunning corset brigade of 18 models in the latest style. For the Jew of women, hips are no longer down to the knees, the waist line is more closely defined and the fair sex again will be able to walk and dance with an easy swing.

Skirts to Be Short. Soft, flowing line, draped effects, dainty, old-fashioned flishes, falling laces, ruffles and fur-bows, quaint streamers, huge billowing skirts, are indicated by the models representing what women will wear this Spring.

The dictum has gone forth that skirts for smart functions positively will be from 19 to 11 inches from the floor. And the waist will be from five to 12 yards. Fullness over the hips will continue, and feather-boning exaggerate the flare of the skirt.

Colors for evening and chic afternoon affairs will be bright, the favorites being combinations of roses, the other extreme much liked being "peach gray." Silvers and cloths are much used in combinations.

Georgette Crepe Favorite. Georgette crepe is a prime favorite, and according to F. Mitchell, president of the Chicago Garment Manufacturers' Association, the American Georgette crepe is more durable and substantial than the foreign crepe.

The top coats for outing in Spring, mackintosh, quilting and like, are full, the favorite fabrics being corduroy satins, white chinchilla, chenille satin striped novelties, raccoon coats (with a stripe not so heavy as corduroy), black striped velvet, toiled leather and duvetyne.

Some clever cap effects were noticed. For Summer flapper-hats will be much worn, combined with faces of all the plant varieties.

The garden frocks are sometimes built on six or eight petaloid foundations and will be billowing.

**GERMAN CONSULS INDICTED**

San Francisco, Feb. 8.—News from Washington of the voted indictments of high consular officials of the German consulate here anticipated by at least two days, the bomb blasting admitted in the light of dispatches, that among those against whom indictments have been voted are included the following:

Francis Bopp, Consul-General for Germany.  
Baron E. H. Von Schack, Vice-Consul-General for Germany.  
Henry W. E. Kaufmann, Chancellor of the German Consulate.  
Maximilian H. Hall, Consul-General for Turkey.  
Fred Johnson, former owner of the steamer Maestran.

Johnnie Koelberg, alleged agent of the German Consulate.  
Dr. Simon Reimer, said to be a German navy officer.  
"Frederick Williams" thought to be a fictitious name.

There were in all 32 indictments voted charging violations of neutrality. Five having to do with bomb blasting included the names of Bopp and Von Schack.

There will be returned on Thursday in all, it was said by John W. Preston, United States Attorney, 19 indictments, and 27 of those, it was said, were against immigration inspectors and officials, officers of consulates and Chinese in connection with the smuggling of Chinese.

The other three bomb plot indictments are new charges against Baron George Wilhelm Von Brincken, an attaché of the German Consulate, C. C. Dandruffy heads become hairless.

**ARMOR THREAT IGNORED**

SENATE COMMITTEE VOTES FOR GOVERNMENT PLANT.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 8.—A bill for a government armor plate factory was approved by the Senate naval committee today within a few minutes after manufacturers had served notice that they would not accept the price charged by the Government for armor made by private concerns which is increased nearly one-half.

An appropriation of \$11,000,000 is carried by the bill for purchase or construction of a Government plant with an annual output of not less than 30,000 tons, that is little more than would be required for two first-class battleships, and would leave a large part of the armor needed in the Navy's increasing program to come from private plants.

The threat of the private manufacturers was communicated to the committee by Senator Penrose, who said the Bethlehem and Midvale companies were among those who had agreed to an increase of 50 per cent if the Government failed to accept their program.

Senator Tillman, chairman of the committee and author of the bill, told Mr. Penrose that "the threat of the armor barons" could not prevent passage of the measure. "I guess we can find a way to stop the robbers," he added.

"In time of trouble we could seize their plants and operate them by right of eminent domain," he said.

The proposed Government plant has the backing of Secretary Daniels and Senator Tillman will press his bill for early passage.

**WAR AND CROPS IMPROVE CONDITIONS IN DOMINION.**

Continuance of Commercial Activities Is Predicted by Lord Shaughnessy, Visiting America.

NEW YORK, Feb. 8.—(Special.)—The following interview with Lord Shaughnessy appeared in the Morning Sun today.

"Canada," said Lord Shaughnessy, "is in a much better position now, commercially, industrially and financially, than she was a year ago. The great improvement is due partly to the increased business arising because of the war conditions, but mostly to the bountiful crops which the Dominion has harvested.

The purchasing power of the producer has increased and is reflected in the general improvement in merchandise and traffic. I look for a continuance of this activity for some months to come. Of course, like all countries where agriculture is the basis of wealth and production, the question of crops will again become vital. But I cannot help feeling that we have passed over the worst period, have surmounted the most formidable obstacles and that Canada is on the upgrade—again a brave, strong, young nation.

"I hope that we will go on with our usual conservation, being careful to glimpse what is around the corner before we leap too far. Perhaps I am not as optimistic as I should be, but I try to look at things from a business man's standpoint. There is no more reason to close one's eyes to favorable signs than to shut them to unfavorable signs. I have tried to strike a balance, and I find that it is distinctly promising for Canada."
