

OATS SALES HIGHER

Market Advances With Strong Eastern Demand.

DEALS AT \$30.40 BASIS

Barley Is Also Moving at Better Prices—Wheat Trading in Northwest Is Still Limited, With Farmers Holding Back.

The oat market is very firm throughout the interior as a result of the continued Eastern demand. Sales were reported at country points yesterday at equal to \$30.40 basis.

Trading in wheat is gradually reviving throughout the Northwest, though farmers here are presenting their grain on the market. A good deal of wheat previously bought is being ordered out, and supplies of some of the warehouses are clearing up.

Definite steps are being taken by the foreign governments to take over the purchase of wheat and other grains. It is understood that the American representatives will be located in New York and will represent the English, French and Italian governments.

The latest Liverpool market news shows a decline in prices since January 1914, of Canadian, Australian and Argentine wheat to the 50 per cent, representing a rise of 50 per cent, while freights have advanced to 200 per cent in the same period, or a rise of 200 per cent.
