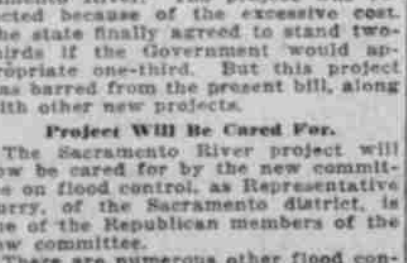

PITTSBURGH, Feb. 14.—Secretary Daniels was taken to task by S. Stanwood Menden, president of the National Security League, in an address at the annual banquet of the Engineers' Society of Western Pennsylvania here tonight.
