

STATE TITLE GOLF TOURNAMENT IS ARRANGED

Qualifying Rounds for Men Will Be Held at Waverley Club Monday, June 5.

HANDICAP PLAN GIVEN OUT

Decisions on Basis Will Be Made by Committee in Charge Before Players Tee Off—Prizes to Be Given Winners.

In anticipation of a highly successful state championship golf tourney, C. H. Davis, Jr., chairman of the handicaps and tournament committee at the Waverley Country Club, has announced his programme for the big Oregon golf championship.

The state championships will be played as usual over the links of the Waverley Country Club. The games this year begin Monday, June 5, and last Saturday, June 10, which will bring it during Rose Festival week as an added attraction for the big civic celebration.

The qualifying rounds in the men's championship will be played commencing at 9 o'clock, over the 36-hole route and the finals are scheduled for Saturday at the same hour.

The women's qualifying rounds will be played on Tuesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock and the finals on Friday.

All handicaps will be made by the committee in charge before the players tee off, the handicap being decided by a rule in use by the Western Golf Association.

Suitable prizes will be given the winners and runners-up in all events, and, in addition, there are trophies for the winners in the driving, approaching and putting contests and the daily caddy golf.
