NAVAL BASE HOPE HIGH

COMMITTEE SECRETARY OPTIMISTIC OVER OUTLOOK OF PLANS.
 Oregon Delegation Is Declared to Be Working as Unit and Strong Favorable Sentiment Reported.

"With hearings soon to be held before the Senate and House naval committees and with the entire Oregon delegation working as a unit for the Columbia River naval base, the outlook for success is distinctly favorable," said Wallace R. Struble, secretary of the naval base committee, last night.

"Our committee has known from the beginning that every member of the Oregon congressional delegation has been favorable to the first-class naval base programme, for this fact is proved by numerous letters and telegrams received from Senators and Representatives both by our committee and commercial and other organizations and citizens of Portland.

"But, while the Oregon men have been willing, it has only been recently that they have begun to sense the fact (known to our Chairman F. C. Harley and by him communicated to our committee) that there is a strong favorable sentiment in Congress, both in the Senate and House naval committees and among the rank and file of both houses, for the Columbia naval base measure. Assured of the correctness of its information, our naval base committee has been active in stirring up organizations and individual citizens of Portland to wire our delegation to act unitedly and vigorously for hearings and consideration of the Columbia River naval base measure immediately. The flood of telegrams that has gone to Washington has stirred our delegation to renewed action."

Naval Militia Is Recruiting.
 MARSHFIELD, Or., May 11.—(Special.)—Following a meeting held here, at which Adjutant-General George White, of the Oregon National Guard, and Naval Militia Instructor G. H. Blair were present, Capt. Bay decided to make a campaign of recruiting for a naval militia division, and is soliciting men for the size and meetings are being held forward the movement. A satisfactory start has been made, and the officers expect to muster the command before the end of the week. The muster roll closes on May 15, and it is expected the division will be organized and drilled on their way to accompany the Alaska cruise of the Marblehead in July.
