Steamer Photinia Is Coming for Lumber Cargo.

WAIMARINO IS EN ROUTE

Latest Vessel Scheduled to Arrive From Australia About June 15 to Take on About 1400 Tons of Paper.

Under charter to the Pacific Export Lumber Company, the British steamer Photinia is expected to get into the river either Tuesday or Wednesday of this week, and will take on a cargo of lumber for Europe.

The Photinia is a vessel of 2853 tons and is capable of handling between 2000 and 3000 tons of lumber. On her arrival in the river she will be taken to Kalama for loading.
