

ITALY IN CABINET RESIGNS

Defeat of Government's Interior Budget in Chamber of Deputies Brings Action.

Premier Salandra Heads Movement to Quit—Minority to Remain in Power Until King Decides on New Men.

ROME, June 11.—The Italian Cabinet, headed by Premier Salandra, resigned today.

The action of the ministry resulted from the failure of the Italian Chamber of Deputies yesterday to pass a vote of confidence in the government, following the presentation of the budget of the Minister of the Interior.

Belief exists here that the Ministerial crisis will soon be ended. All political parties, it is contended, favor the present Ministry containing Baron Sonnino, the Minister of Foreign Affairs, and the present Military Ministers.

The government failed to obtain a majority on a vote in the Chamber of Deputies on the budget of the Minister of the Interior.

All parties agree that the new Italian cabinet must have a national character. It is suggested that it comprise all the leading statesmen with a view to uniting in the supreme struggle all political opinion except that of the intransigent Socialists, about 40 of whom oppose the war as a principle.

From all sides a rapid solution of the crisis is urged owing to the gravity of the moment.

Disension is frequent. The present cabinet, under the Premiership of Salandra, resigned in May, 1915, as a result of a crisis precipitated by expenditures for war preparations and the question of taxation.

On several occasions disension has arisen between the cabinet and its opponents of the government which threatened to disrupt the ministry, but the Chamber of Deputies on each occasion passed a vote of confidence in the government.

Premier Salandra in a statement to the chamber said that he had resigned "in the present grave and historic moment I can affirm with certainty the loyal and effective solidarity of the entire cabinet."

OFFICIAL WAR REPORTS

German. BERLIN, via London, June 11.—The text of today's official report is: "Western theater—On both sides of the Meuse there was violent artillery fighting. The booty announced yesterday from the fighting on the east bank of the river was further increased by three cannon and seven machine guns.

French. PARIS, June 11.—The text of today's official statement follows: "Between the Oise and the Aisne our artillery continued to bombard enemy works in the woods of St. Marthen. "In the Argonne the mine fighting continues to our advantage. At Haute Marthe we have completely checked the small line which destroyed enemy subterranean works, an explosion of two German mines produced a single crater 30 meters in diameter, the edge of which was occupied on three sides.

Russian. PETROGRAD, June 11.—The text of the Russian official statement follows: "On the front north of Verdun there was intensive fighting on the east bank of the Meuse. On the left bank two enemy assaults upon our positions on Hill 304 and another east of this hill were completely checked. "There was no infantry action on the right bank. In the forest of Apremont two small enemy detachments which had penetrated into our advanced trenches, were ejected with losses after a hand-to-hand combat.

Italian. ROME, June 11.—The text of today's official statement is: "Yesterday the enemy concentrated his efforts against the narrow sector of our front of Asiago, where, after our heroic resistance, a new division in massed formation repeatedly on our front because it left our doors open to our traditional enemy. These unfavorable conditions rendered the first undeniable successes of the enemy's offensive possible, but we must recognize that better prepared defenses might have longer arrested the enemy's advance, keeping it farther from the Venetian plains.

British. AN OFFICIAL BRITISH TABULATION of German losses to the end of May gives aggregate casualties of 224,286, of which 73,412 represents men killed. These losses are declared to be exclusion of those sustained in naval engagements and the fighting in the colonies.

Paris, June 11.—Three German infantry attacks against the French trenches on Hill 304 and the positions east of the elevation in the Argonne were completely checked last night by the French troops, says the latest statement issued at the War Department here tonight.

Berlin, via London, June 11.—Violent artillery fighting is in progress on both sides of the River Meuse, north of the French fortress of Verdun, according to the German official statement issued today.

35,000 Austrians Taken. Russian Swell List of Prisoners in Drive on Eastern Front. Petrograd, via London, June 11.—In the fighting yesterday on the front of Volhynia and Galicia, says the official statement issued here today, the Russians took 39 officers and 35,000 men. They also captured 20 guns and an enormous quantity of booty.
