LONDON, June 23.—The official announcement by the Russian War Office of the capture of Radauts, a city of 18,000 inhabitants, situated 30 miles south of Czernowitz and 19 miles from the Russian frontier, shows how actively General Letchitzky is pursuing the broken Austrian forces.
