FIREMAN IS DISCHARGED

L. C. Benfield's Reinstatement Declared Due to Inadvertence.

L. C. Benfield, fireman, who was reinstated by the Municipal Civil Service Board Thursday, was discharged by Fire Chief Dowell and Mayor Albee yesterday on a charge of conduct unbecoming a fireman. The fire officials say the reinstatement was through inadvertence.

Benfield is charged with being one of several arrested a year ago for alleged improper relations with a girl of tender years. Soon after his arrest he was tried, and the jury in his case disagreed. He did not return to the fire service until recently, and never having been discharged, the Civil Service Board put him back to work. The reinstatement did not prejudice any charge held against Benfield.

LECTURE PLACE CHANGED

Dr. Ernest H. Lindley's Business Talks to Be at Lincoln High.

The series of Reed College extension lectures being given by Dr. Ernest H. Lindley on "Psychology in Relation to Commerce and Industry" have become so popular that Library Hall has been found inadequate to accommodate the crowds and the place has therefore been changed to Lincoln High School auditorium, where, tonight, the particular subject is "Will Power." Hundreds have been turned away at each lecture in the Library, and as Lincoln

auditorium seats 1200 it is believed those interested in the lectures can be accommodated.

Dr. Lindley is visiting professor at Reed College from Indiana University. The lectures are free and under the direction of the extension department of Reed College.

Southern Pacific Line Guarded.

ROSEBURG, Or., Feb. 13.—(Special).—It was reported here today that armed guards have been placed at the bridges and tunnels of the Southern Pacific company in Douglas County. The guard over the tunnels and bridges will be maintained until the crisis between Germany and the United States has

passed. There are a number of long tunnels in Southern Douglas County, which, if destroyed, would completely tie up traffic on the southern Pacific lines between Portland and San Francisco for several days.
