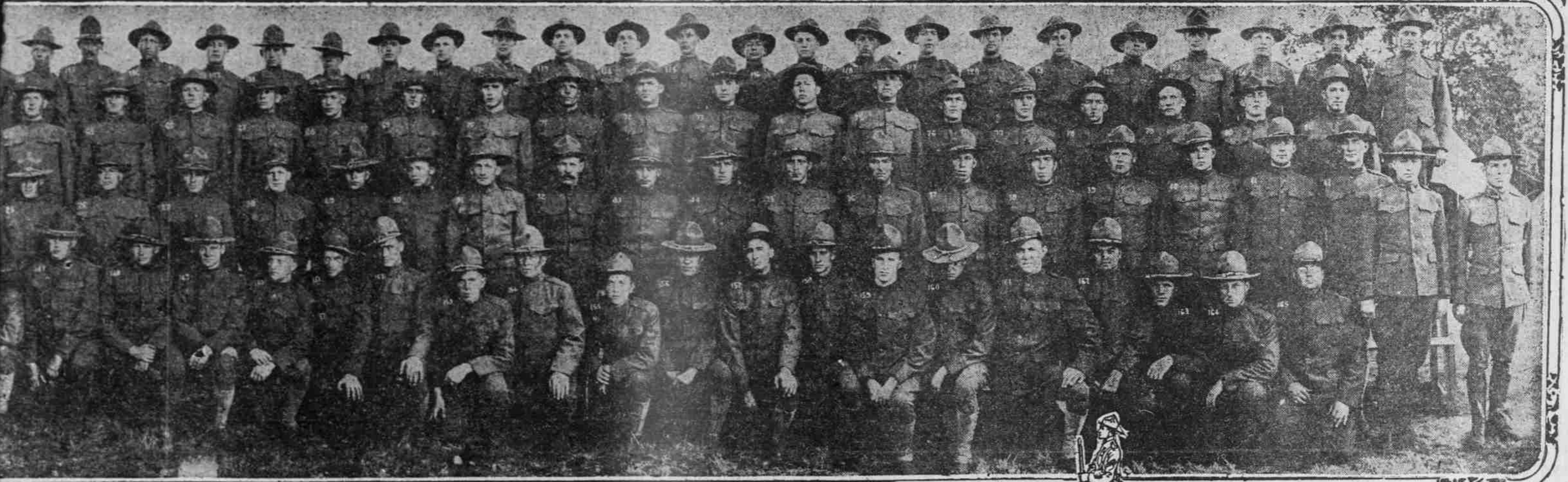
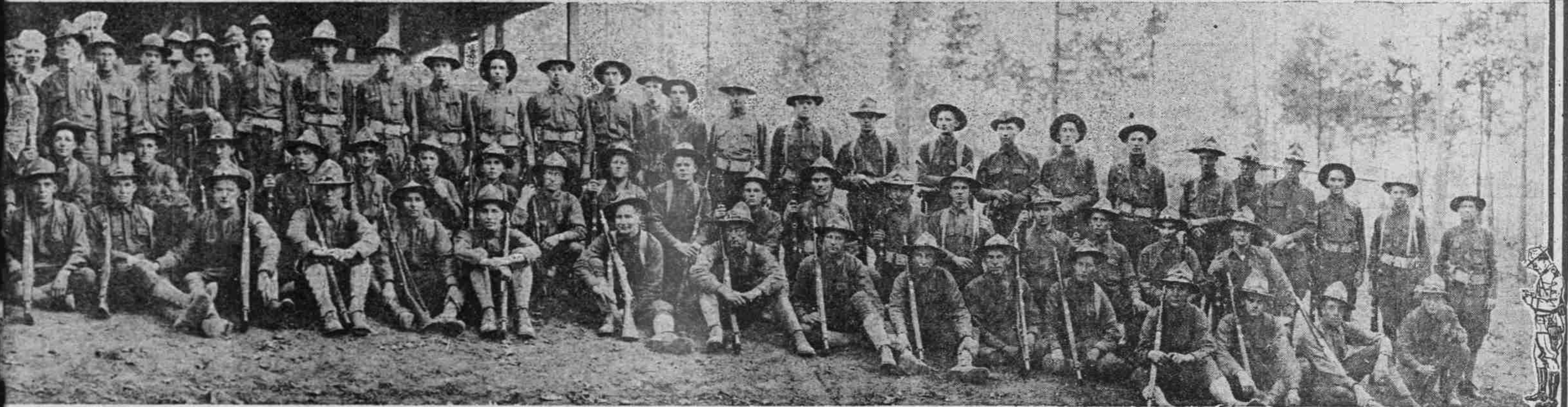
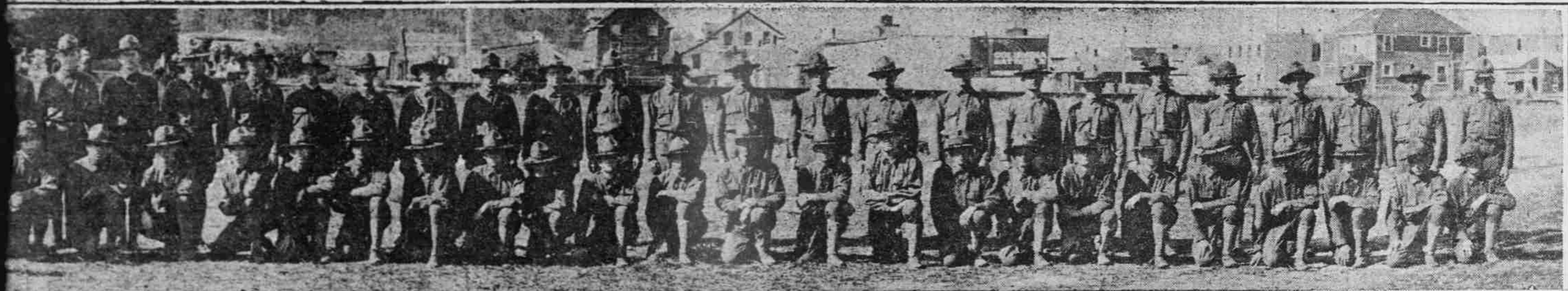
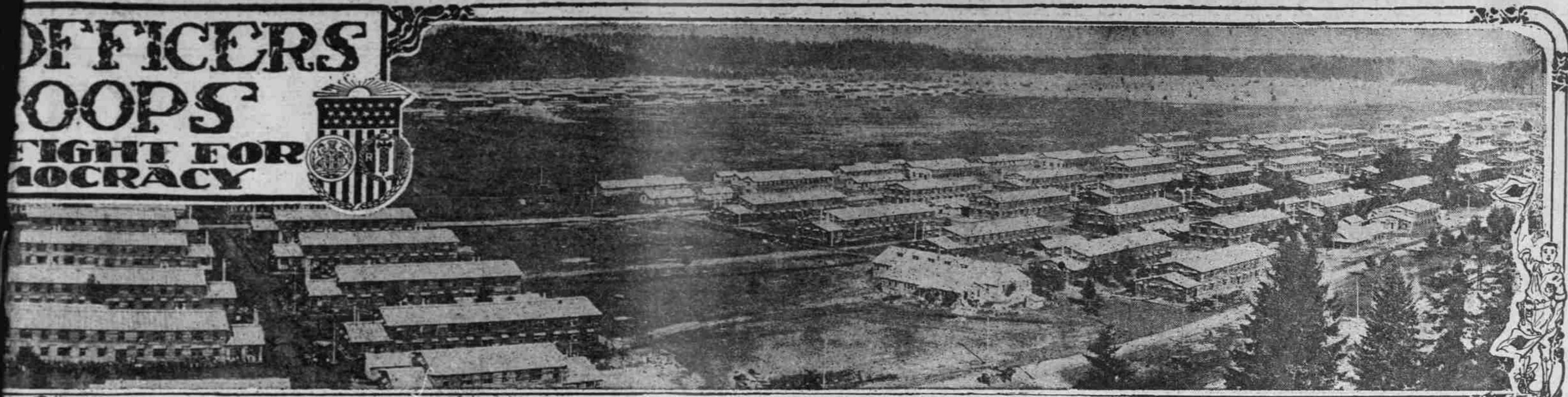


OFFICERS COOPS FIGHT FOR DEMOCRACY
