Camp Lewis Notes.

TACOMA, Jan. 20.—Smashing a window in a gun store shortly after 2 o'clock Sunday morning, an unidentified soldier seized a .32-caliber revolver and box of cartridges and ran to a room in a hotel nearby, where he was found dead with a bullet in his head a few minutes later by the police. All marks of identification had been removed from his clothing. He had registered at the hotel Saturday night as H. C. Vincent, but a ring which he wore bore the initials "H. E. B." The body was removed to Camp Lewis this afternoon.

KALAMA, Wash., Jan. 20.—(Special.)—The body of Leonard Jacobs, who recently died in North Worth, Tex., of pneumonia following measles, arrived here Thursday and is lying in state at the Carlson opera-house. The funeral was held today. The pallbearers were soldiers from Vancouver, among them Henry Darnell, Rodney Jones, Frank Jones and A. C. Roby, all of this city. Young Jacobs was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Jacobs, of this city. His brothers, Richard, Donovan and Lloyd, also are in the service. Practically every young man of military age of this city is in the service and this is the first fatality.

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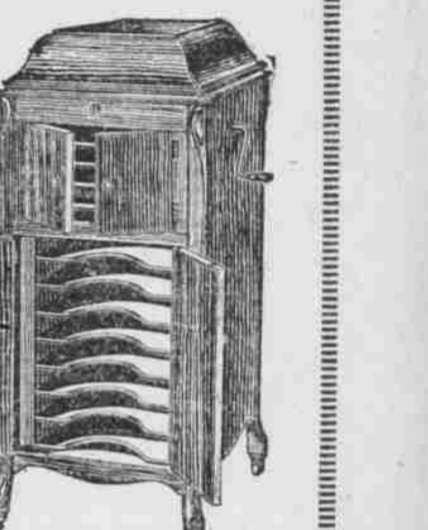
