

HANSON'S LEAD IN FINAL COUNT 4629

Anna L. Strong is Recalled From School Board by Vote of Nearly 6000.

SEATTLE TAXES TO RISE

People Vote Bonding Propositions Which Will Increase Rate From 2.5 Mills to 3 Mills—Many Appointments to Be Made.

SEATTLE, Wash., March 6.—(Special.)—Complete returns from Tuesday's municipal election show that Ole Hanson was elected Mayor by a majority of 4629 votes over his opponent, James E. Bradford. Hanson received 32,397 and Bradford 28,773.

The recall of Anna Louise Strong from the School Board was effected by a vote of approximately 5700. Bonding propositions adopted by the voters increased the taxation of the city from 2 1/2 to 3 mills. Only one of the bonding propositions is in doubt, one calling for \$110,000 to be used in a certain local improvement district, and unofficial returns show it to be six votes behind the required 60 per cent vote to carry it.

The School Board will meet tomorrow night to canvass the returns. Miss Strong will not be a party to the proceedings. After the returns have been certified she will be notified of her recall, the place declared vacant, and the board will proceed to elect her successor to serve until the school election next December.

Mayor-elect Hanson will take office March 18. He has several important appointments to make, including Chief of Police, Chief of Fire Department, Health Commissioner, Harbor Masters, members of the Board of Public Works and Civil Service Commission. The Mayor also will appoint a secretary.

The successful Councilman candidates were Thomas H. Holton, A. F. Hines, who were re-elected, and Richard W. Cotterill, secretary of the City Park Board, who will succeed Will H. Hanna, candidate for re-election to the Council, who failed to receive the list of new city officials. Official returns give Holton 56,431 votes, Cotterill 22,124, Hines 23,947, Ed L. Terry and Harry W. Carey, who were re-elected, 10,000 each.

Candidates for the positions of City Treasurer and Controller, respectively, each received a large vote, and Hugh H. Caldwell overwhelmed his opponent, John T. Casey, by a vote of 29,895 to 8927.
