

Formal Negotiations Opened With Republicans to Prevent Election of Socialists. MOVE MADE IN WISCONSIN

OREGONIAN NEWS BUREAU, Washington, March 7.—The proposal of a Democratic and Republican fusion to prevent the election of Socialists to Congress has gone so far that the Democratic National committee has designated Fred H. Lynch, National committee chairman from Minnesota, and a party leader, to open formal negotiations with the Republican National committee and the Republican Congressional committee.

Democrats Move on Wisconsin. Wisconsin is the first state where the Democrats have made an active move. There is a Senate vacancy to be filled, and Governor Phillip proposes calling a special session of the Legislature to permit him to fill the Senate vacancy by appointment.

The Democratic answer to Governor Phillip was to name Joseph M. Davies, chairman of the Federal Trade Commission, back to Wisconsin to work against the Governor's proposal and to announce his own candidacy for Governor.

Fusion Proposed in Many States. Fusion has been proposed in all states where there is a party, or what is called, Nonpartisan League, or Socialist party.
