INTEREST RATES UP

Allies Must Pay 5 Per Cent on Future Loans.

MONEY IN AMERICA HIGHER

Credit Granted by United States to Nations Associated With It in War Have Reached Total of \$1,734,100,000.

WASHINGTON, March 8 .- The Interest rates on loans to allies has been raised from 4% per cent to 5 per cent as a result of the recent increase in the rates on certificates of indebted-

ness from 4 to 4% per cent. Since it now costs the United States Government more to horrow money from the American people, Secretary McAdoo felt it necessary to charge more for the allied toans, although

these transactions mean practically no prefit to the United States.

The interest rates on allied loans have risen gradually from 2 per cent on the first credits last April, when the Government was borrowing at that

the Government was borrowing at that rate on certificates.

Later the leading rate was increased to 3½ per cent and then to 3½ per cent to accord with the rate on the first liberty loan. Funds obtained from the second liberty loan at 4 per cent, were loaned to the allies at 4½. Credits to the allies now amount to \$4,734,400,000 and \$4,356,400,000 has actually been raid out. Of the \$1348,000. tually been paid out. Of the \$248,000,credited to the Russian government, at-though no demands are being presented by Russian officials for payment.

LONDON, March 8.—The House of Commons late last night agreed unanimously to the vote of credit of 1800,000,000 moved yesterday by the Chancellor of the Exchequer, Andrew Bonar Law. This brings the total of the votes of credit during the war to £6,842,000,000.


