

## INTEREST RATES UP

Allies Must Pay 5 Per Cent on Future Loans.

## MONEY IN AMERICA HIGHER

Credit Granted by United States to Nations Associated With It in War Have Reached Total of \$1,734,400,000.

WASHINGTON, March 8.—The interest rates on loans to allies has been raised from 4 1/4 per cent to 5 per cent as a result of the recent increase in the rates on certificates of indebtedness from 4 to 4 1/4 per cent. Since it now costs the United States Government more to borrow money from the American people, Secretary McAdoo felt it necessary to charge more for the allied loans, although these transactions mean practically no profit to the United States.

The interest rates on allied loans have risen gradually from 2 per cent on the first credits last April, when the Government was borrowing at that rate on certificates.

Later the leading rate was increased to 2 1/4 per cent and then to 3 1/4 per cent in accord with the rate on the first liberty loan. Funds obtained from the second liberty loan at 4 per cent, were loaned to the allies at 4 1/4. Credits to the allies now amount to \$4,734,400,000 and \$4,286,400,000 has actually been paid out. Of the \$248,000,000 unpaid balance, \$137,000,000 is still credited to the Russian government, although no demands are being presented by Russian officials for payment.

LONDON, March 8.—The House of Commons late last night agreed unanimously to the vote of credit of £400,000,000 moved yesterday by the Chancellor of the Exchequer, Andrew Bonar Law. This brings the total of the votes of credit during the war to £8,842,500,000.

## ENEMY LIVING COSTS SOAR

Half of Average German Family's Expenditures Is for Food.

WASHINGTON, March 8.—The seriousness of the cost of living problem in Germany is shown in figures announced today by the Department of Labor, which show that 52 1/4 per cent of the average German family's expenditure is paid for food.

Fresh meat is scarce and smoked and conserved meats are high in price, while fish is two and one-half to four times higher than in peace times. Potatoes are being substituted for grain and substitutes of all kinds are being used, especially by the poorer classes. Jam very largely has taken the place of butter and oleomargarine.

## BERLIN APOLOGIZES, PAYS

Dutch Government Compensated for Attack on Rijndijk.

THE HAGUE, March 8.—The Dutch Foreign Office announces that it has received compensation from Germany for damage to the property of the Belgian relief commission resulting from a submarine attack on the Dutch steamer Rijndijk on April 7, 1916.

The Rijndijk was beached after the attack, but her cargo was damaged by water. Germany apologized to Holland for the attack in August, 1916, and last November it was announced at The Hague that she had paid compensation for damaging the Rijndijk.

## Charles Follen Adams Dies.

BOSTON, March 8.—Charles Follen Adams, author of dialect stories and poems and known through his frequent appearances as a public reader, died at his home here today. He was 78 years old.
