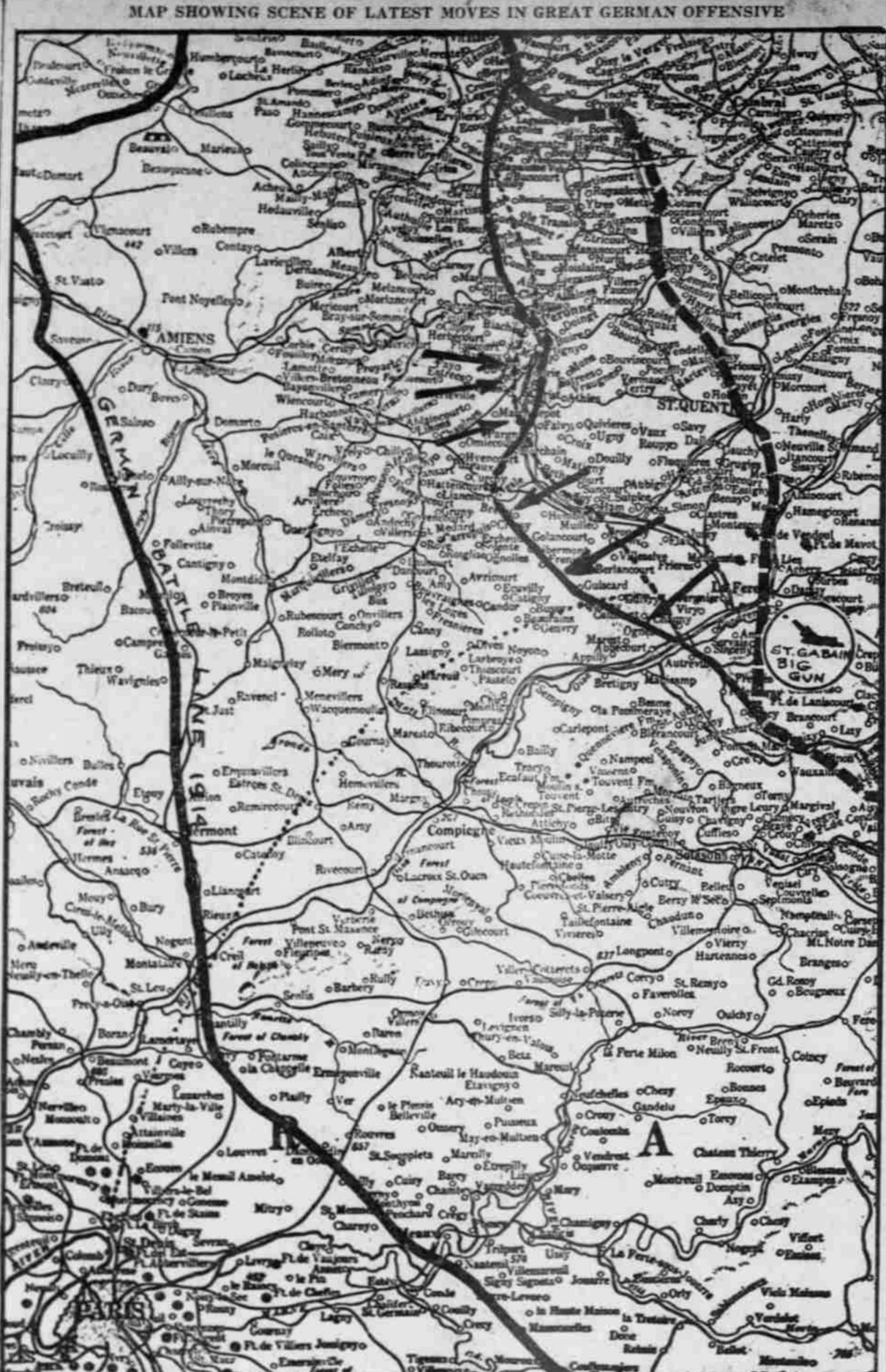
Germans Hurl Fresh Armies of Infantry Into Attack on Heroic Defenders.
