

GUARD WILL BE ARMED

GOVERNOR ORDERS 4000 RIFLES FOR STATE PROTECTION. Plan Has Been Worked Out Whereby Guards May Enter Service Independent of Military Police.

Governor Withycombe has requested the military department for equipping the Home Guard throughout the state.

A plan has been worked out by which the Home Guards may be mustered into the military service, independent of the Oregon Military Police organization that is proposed.

"Under the present appropriation for military expenses," says Adjutant-General Williams, in a circular letter, "it will be impossible to equip the Home Guards with uniforms or equipment other than rifles and ammunition.
