PEACE MOVE FUTILE

Alleged Agent Meets Chilly Reception in England.

REPORT IS NOT CREDITED

The Hague Credits Jonkhoe Colyn With Being Bearer of German Proposals to Britain for Ending of Hostilities.

LONDON, May 6.—Foreign Secretary Balfour told the House of Commons today that no peace offers had been made recently by the enemy. He added: "There is no representative of a neutral nation in this country who has made tentative or informal suggestions of peace negotiations."

In any direction. There is reason to believe, it says, that the German agent, who has been reported to be a Dutch financier, returns to Germany to report that there is nothing doing.

A Central News dispatch from The Hague says the Dutch intermediary is reported to be Jonkhoe Colyn, ex-Minister of War.

The proposals made by Jonkhoe Colyn, the dispatch reports, are said there to have been as follows:

1. Germany to renounce all claims in the west.
2. Restoration of Belgium.
3. Alsace-Lorraine to be autonomous, within the German federation.
4. The status in the east to remain as at present.
5. Austria to make certain concessions to Italy in the Trentino.
6. Balkan question to be solved by an international conference.
7. All colonial questions affecting Africa and Asia Minor to be settled by a conference of all the belligerents.

Jonkhoe Colyn went to England last week at the head of a mission whose purpose was said to be to explain to the British the difficulties caused by Germany's demand on Holland concerning the transfer of German materials across Holland to Belgium.

WASHINGTON, May 6.—Officials and diplomats here on reading Germany's purported peace terms, as outlined today in dispatches from London, recalled that British officials recently predicted a "peace offensive," and said, furthermore, that they expected that terms to be offered in behalf of Germany would be framed so as to appear most attractive to Great Britain.

Today's dispatches, officials declared, seemed to fulfill that prediction.

Every peace move made by Germany since her first offer has been promptly branded by the allied statesmen as subtle propaganda, to sow dissension and discord among the allied people, weaken their resistance and to lead to what has been characterized as a German-made peace.

Foreign Minister Balfour's positive statement in the House of Commons that no suggestion of peace negotiations had come to Great Britain through a neutral seemed to put the situation beyond the realm of serious consideration.

Valley Projects Inspected.

GRANTS PASS, Or., May 6.—(Special.)—R. B. Teal, irrigation engineer of the U. S. Department of Agriculture, formerly of Washington, D. C., but now stationed at Berkeley, stopped off here today to look over the Grants Pass and Gold Hill projects, which have just been approved by the Federal Reserve Board, and on which construction will start immediately. He came here from Talent, where he made an investigation of that project, preparatory to making a report to the capital issues committee of the Federal Board.

SUFFRAGE SET BACK

Senate Refuses to Consider House Resolution.

VOTE DEEMED SIGNIFICANT

Preliminary Lineup Believed to Afford Indication of Sentiment and to Suggest Final Defeat of Measure.

WASHINGTON, May 6.—By a margin of one vote, a motion proposing that the Senate proceed next Friday to consider the House woman suffrage resolution to the Constitution was defeated in the Senate today. The vote was 40 to 21, just less than the necessary two-thirds.

Although the vote was on beginning debate only, most of those voting were believed to have recorded themselves on the way they would vote on the resolution itself, which the House adopted last January. If the line-up of today is maintained, the resolution would be defeated.

Today's vote came on a motion of Chairman Jones, of the Senate suffrage committee, to proceed with the House resolution Friday. Previously Senator Jones had announced that he would endeavor to take up and dispose of the resolution, the latter part of the week.

Monday at the members' council of the Portland Chamber of Commerce will be the Mayor's luncheon, and this will be followed through the week with luncheons at the Rotary Club, Ad Club, East Side Business Men's Club, Realty Board and other organizations.

Besides the luncheons the general committee will carry on the propaganda of "potatriotism" in the theaters, hotels and other places and will conduct demonstrations with a purpose of enlightening people to the fact that there are more ways to make potatoes palatable than boiling or baking.

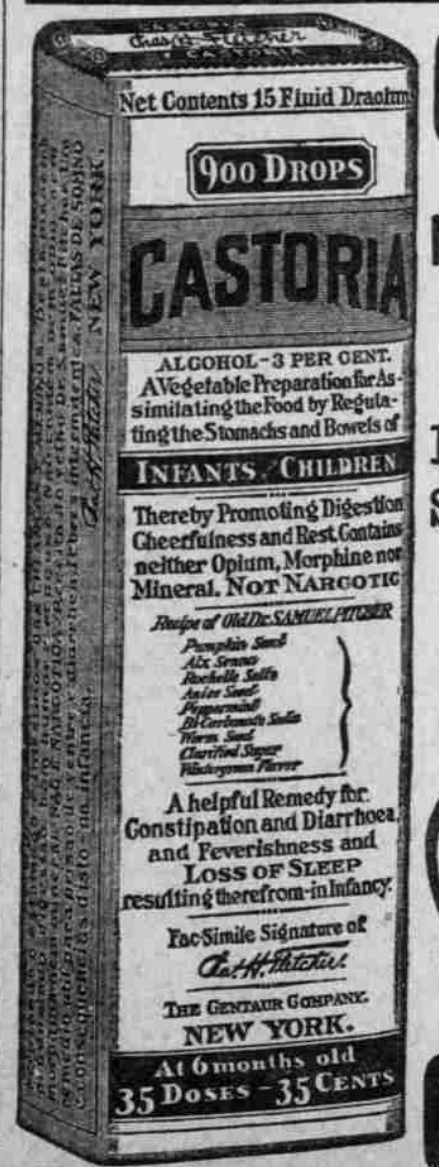
