## PAROLE RIGHT AFFIRMED

SECTION OF ACT OF 1917.

Becision of Circuit Judge Knowles in Tong War Case Is Upheld. Sentence Passed Also Upheld.

SALEM. May 28.—(Special)—In affirming Circuit Judge Knowles, of Union County, in the appeal of Chong Ben, Wong One and Li Hung, Chief Justice McBride, of the Supreme Court today holds that Section 17, of an act of 1917. relating to paroles and indeterminate sentences, is void insofar as it en-deavors to timit the right to parole. This section provided that the court could not parole a prisoner while his cause is on appeal to the Supreme

The case affirmed today developed in connection with the tong war, and the defendants were convicted on a charge of assault with intent to kill.
Appellants contended that the sentence passed was frong under the law
of 1917, which changes the indeterminate sentence law, but the court holds that the old law is still good as it relates to crimes committed prior to the act of 1917 becoming effective. In the case of Thomas Malloy versus Marshall-Wells Hardware Company,
