\$2.40 WHEAT VETOED

President Declares Farmers' Loyalty Above Price.

WASHINGTON, July 12.—In vetoing the \$2,000,000 annual agricultural appropriation bill because of its amendment fixing the Government guaranteed minimum wheat price at \$2.40 a bushel, the President informed Congress today that he did not believe the farmers of America "depend upon a stimulation of price to do their utmost to serve the Nation and the world at this time of crisis."

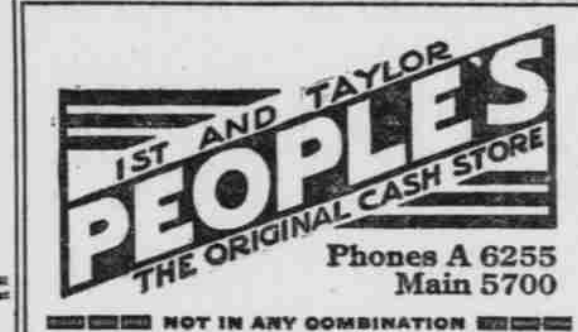
