LONDON, Aug. 5.—Reuter's corre-spondent at British headquarters in France, in a telegram dated Monday night at 9:55 o'clock, says: DANCING

The abbing of the German morale esulting from recent events has been acticeably hastened by the great influx of American troops. In this particular regard the German high command is paying the penalty of concealment and misrepresentation.

The appearance in the battle line of powerful American forces and the striking proof of their splendid fighting qualities gives the lie direct to all German official bombast which no explain-ing can minimize. Moreover, M proves the futility of all the tall talk about the cess of the German submarine warfare

Tare. "Distrust is rife in the enemy ranks, and under such conditions the tendency is to exaggerate their misfortune. They discredit Ludendorff's statements and seem gloomily conscious that Germany is suffering defeat and the truth is be-ing conceased from them."
