NEARLY 700,000 BUSHELS

Bank clearings of the Northwest cities yesterday were as follows: Portland \$1,542,000; Astoria \$1,450,000; Seattle \$1,444,339; Tacoma \$1,020,933; Spokane \$1,018,765.

Local Arrivals of Oats, Barley and Hay Also Exceed Those of Northern Ports; Market Is Quiet and Steady.

There is an unusually heavy movement of wheat to Portland. Since the beginning of the cereal year the receipts have been 600,000 bushels, or about twice the combined receipts of Seattle and Tacoma. This is due in part to the earlier harvest in the Portland territory. The advance of the season is also shown by the fact that local arrivals are about twice as large as at this time last year.
