

8 WEEK GOVERNOR'S CHAIR; ALL HOPEFUL

California Primary Election
Today Notable for Number of Candidates.

FORD TO RUN ON 2 TICKETS

Michigan Campaign Has Unusual Feature—Missouri G. O. P. Will Indorse Prosecution of War to Finish.

SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 26.—While a complete state ticket will be nominated in tomorrow's primary election, chief interest centers in the race for the gubernatorial nomination because of the unusually large number of candidates, eight being aspirants for the nomination.

Supporters of Governor William D. Stephens, Republican candidate, and Mayor James Rolph, of San Francisco, who seeks both the Republican and Democratic nominations, contended tonight that the race lies between these two candidates.

All other candidates, in statements issued today, predicted their own success at the polls. The Democratic nominations are sought by Francis J. Haney, Thomas Lee Woolwine and James Rolph.

The Republican candidates are Walter Bordwell, Charles M. Pickett, J. O. Hayes, William D. Stephens, James Rolph and C. A. McGee.

Eleven districts to nominate. Candidates also will be chosen in each of the state's 11 congressional districts. The registered vote is 1,623,678.

COLUMBIA, S. C., Aug. 26.—Two candidates for the United States Senate will be nominated tomorrow by the Democratic party in South Carolina state-wide primary.

For the full term beginning next March 4 there are three candidates, Nat B. Dial, James F. Rice and ex-Governor Cole L. Blease.

President Wilson, in a letter written recently to a South Carolina newspaper, said he had "not the least fear" that the people of South Carolina can be a friend of the administration.

Peoples and Pollock in Race. For the two-months' term to succeed Senator Christie Benet, who was appointed to fill the eight-months' unexpired term of the late Senator Tillman, the candidates in addition to Senator Benet are Thomas H. Peoples and W. H. Pollock.

DETROIT, Aug. 26.—Michigan's primary election campaign closed tonight with interest in the Senate race heightened by the fact that Henry Ford's name will appear on both Republican and Democratic tickets.

Three other neck the Republican nomination, Truman H. Newberry, former Governor Chase E. Osborn and William G. Simpson, contending with Ford for the Democratic nomination is James W. Helme.

Ford Offers Plans. The Ford Motor Company has offered the \$1 million prize for the inventor of a machine that will be used in the production of gas masks.

One of the Eastern plants already has been ordered to begin work on the production of gas masks.

ST. LOUIS, Mo., Aug. 26.—Republican leaders have decided there will be no endorsement of the war record of the administration of President Wilson in the Republican state platform to be adopted here tomorrow by the Republican state convention, it became known today.

Instead, it is said, the draft of the platform will contain a strong endorsement of the war and its vigorous prosecution to a successful termination in a decisive suppression of Germany as a power to make war.

It was learned at Republican headquarters the platform will contain nothing in the nature of criticism of President Wilson or the manner of conducting the war, but that there will be "a strong plea for a non-partisan conduct of the war in the future."

NEWARK, N. J., Aug. 26.—Application was filed in the Supreme Court here today to set aside the petition of William Grant Webster, candidate for the Republican Congressional nomination in the Tenth New Jersey district and who is alleged to be a candidate for the same office in the Tenth district of Illinois.

It is charged that Webster is not a bona fide resident of New Jersey.

NO TRIAL FOUND NECESSARY

C. M. Hall, Arrested at Grants Pass, Taken to Penitentiary.

OREGON CITY, Or., Aug. 26.—(Special.)—C. M. Hall, brought back from Grants Pass on a warrant charging him with issuing a worthless check, had a hearing today.

After reading the complaint, Justice Slevens was called by phone from the Penitentiary at Salem, and told that Hall was wanted there as a parole violator. No further action was taken by the justice and Hall was taken to Salem this evening.

Lightning Starts Forest Fire.

LARAMIE, Wyo., Aug. 26.—A forest fire near Laramie Peak burned ranch-houses and several head of cattle owned by a ranchman. The fire started when lightning struck a dead tree. One hundred men from Wheatland are fighting the fire to prevent its spreading to other ranches.
