

SUGAR RISE SHARP

New Jobbing Price Is \$1.50 Per Hundred Higher.

GREATEST ADVANCE KNOWN

Change Will Work No Hardship on Consumers, However, Because of Restricted Quantity That May Be Purchased.

Sugar jobbing prices were advanced \$1.50 a hundred yesterday. This is the greatest single advance ever recorded in the sugar market.

STEADY TONE IN GRAIN MARKET

Yellow Corn. Clipped Oats and Standard Barley Bids Raised.

The coarse grain market was very steady at the opening of the week. Bids at the Merchants Exchange were 50 cents higher on yellow corn, 20 cents on standard barley and 50 cents on Saturday's figures.

Apples are selling to the retailers here at \$1.25 to \$1.50 per fancy Greenstems. Oregon Greenstems of good size and color are going generally at \$1.75 to \$2.00, smaller ones cheaper.

Salmon prices were offered at \$1.40 to \$1.50 and Alaskan salmon continued weak.

Peas were in heavy supply and the demand was poor. A few Barletts only brought \$1.50. Finnish Beauties were offered at \$1.

There was a steady tone to the prune market. Italians jobbed at 23 cents.

Shipments of Oregon Produce.

Bartlett pear shipments reported yesterday were 19 cars to New York, and 10 cars to Chicago.

One car of prunes was reported shipped to Solomon and one car of potatoes to Locust Point.

Carlot shipments of Oregon produce for the season to date were: Apples 2, dried loganberries 4, fresh loganberries 28, dried potatoes 13, dried prunes 108, fresh prunes 17, mixed fruit 8, mixed fruit and vegetables 14, mixed vegetables 4.

Slow Demand for Potatoes.

With a moderate demand the potato market was no more than steady. Burbanks were quoted at \$2.75 to \$3 for good stock and \$2.50 for poorer. Idaho Rums were held at \$2.50.

Onions were weak at last week's quotations.

Receipts of tomatoes declined and the market was firmer. Good ripe unwrapped stock brought 50 cents.

Firmer Feeling in Egg Market.

There was a firmer feeling in the egg market yesterday, but not much change in price. Cabbages were scarce and 55 cents was asked for extras.
