The defendants did not appear in court. The trial, however, was acrimonious in the extreme. Attorneys for both principals in the divorce were present and wrangled over the introduction of evidence that might later be reproduced in the divorce proceedings. Walter Wolfe, attorney for the defendants, announced an appeal of the case.


