

ATHLETIC CLUB OUT AFTER AGGIES' SCALP

Hard Struggle to Be Staged on Corvallis Campus.

REHBEIN VETERAN ON LINE

The Multnomah Amateur Athletic club football team will play the Oregon Aggie team next Saturday. The game was originally scheduled to be played at Multnomah Field, but the state health authorities and Mayor Baker ruled otherwise, owing to the epidemic of Spanish influenza. It was thought for a while that the game would be postponed until later in the season, but yesterday Manager George Beris telegraphed Coach Hargis of the Aggies at Corvallis, and asked if it would be possible to stage the contest on the Corvallis campus. Hargis took the matter up with the college authorities and last night telegraphed Beris bringing the Winged-M eleven to Corvallis.
