Teachers May Forge Pay ATTORNEY-GENERAL IS ASKED FOR LEGAL OPINION.

Suspension of Salaries During Influenza Epidemic Causes Educators to Seek Counsel.

SALEM, Oct. 31. (Special)—District Attorney Evans, of Multnomah County, will ask Attorney-General Brown for an opinion as to the propriety of suspending the salaries of teachers during the influenza epidemic until the legality of the situation is determined.

It is understood there is much dissatisfaction among the school teachers in Portland over the fact that they are unable to secure their salaries.

Superintendent Church has advised Clerk Thomas, of the board, that the salaries should be paid, but it is understood that the clerk desires a legal opinion and has asked District Attorney Evans to furnish one.

It is expected that the District Attorney will put the matter up to the Attorney-General. The Attorney-General's office already has ruled that in the case of a scarlet fever epidemic the school teachers should be paid.

Students Plan War Drive OREGON AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE TO PLEDGE \$9063.

Campaign Will Be Opened With Mass Meeting, Followed by Thorough Canvass.

OREGON AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE, Corvallis, Nov. 1.—(Special)—Plans have been definitely decided upon for the united war drive at this college.

The National quota for the colleges is set at \$5,000,000, and of this Washington, Idaho and Oregon are apportioned \$100,000, and O. A. C.'s share is \$9063.50.

The drive will be opened with a mass meeting, and then solicited will be the companies and their sorority houses and halls.

The woman's committee, selected by the executive committee of the Woman's League, is composed of Natalie Reichart, Agnes Houck, Mary Holmes and Irene Brye.

This will be the first drive of the year in the agricultural colleges, and it will be carried out with a spirit of co-operation on the part of the military unit and the new students.
