Houthuist forest had been converted into an enormous fortress by the Germans. It was the pivot of the whole line between Armentieres and Nieuport. Innumerable redoubts, dugouts and concrete blockhouses were constructed and along every road traversing the ferest there are doors leading to subternates shelters, making the whole area resemble a city of cave dwellers.


