

GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATION NOT TO BE DELAYED

Governor Withycombe Replies to War Auxiliaries' Request.

SOLDIERS GET PREFERENCE

Military Protection of State Demands Immediate Attention, Says Executive.

Governor Withycombe has informed the war auxiliaries central committee that he does not feel that the officials of the state would be justified in delaying organization of the National Guard until the Oregon soldiers are returned home.

At a meeting of the organization November 15, a resolution was unanimously adopted petitioning the governor to defer the appointment of officers of the Oregon National Guard until the Oregon boys return, and expressing the belief that the boys who have served overseas should have preference.

"This is to acknowledge your communication of November 15 reporting the resolution passed by the war auxiliaries central committee and to assure you that I am obliged to say that I do not feel that the officials of the state would be justified in delaying the organization of the Oregon National Guard until all of the Oregon soldiers have returned."

"Assuring you of my conscientious purpose in this matter, I am, 'Very truly yours,' 'JAMES W. WITHYCOMBE, Governor."

"The mothers of soldiers still feel that Governor Withycombe should wait a little while before proceeding with the organization of the Oregon National Guard," said Mrs. G. L. Williams, president of the auxiliary central committee.
