Story of Brilliant Achievements Is Annual Report.

NAVAL EXPANSION URGED

New Three Years' Program, With Expenditure of \$600,000,000, Would Produce 156 Battleships.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 8.—With a story of brilliant achievements of the American Navy in the war, Secretary Daniels today, in his annual report made public, today, an urgent recommendation for continued naval expansion to meet the demands of peace for national and international work on the sea.

This reference to the future concludes the report: "The day is not far distant when the world will witness an end of competitive building between nations of mighty weapons of war. In the future there will undoubtedly be incorporated President Wilson's proposal for a reduction of armament to the lowest point consistent with domestic safety."

NEW THREE YEAR'S PROGRAM URGED

"Inasmuch as the United States is the richest of the great nations and has suffered less in the war than any of the allied powers, it will devote upon this country to make a contribution to the Navy to preserve the peace of the world commensurate with its wealth."
