CHURCH SERVICES ARE SET—Services will be held at the Congregation Abayal Sholom Park at 8 o'clock tonight at 9 o'clock.

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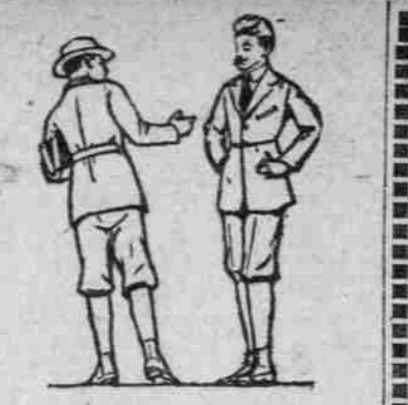
