OCEAN FLIGHT POSTPONED

AIRMEN ADVISED OF STORMS IN MID-ATLANTIC.

Britons Who Came to Grief in Attempt to Make Westward Trip to Make Another Trial.

ST. JOHN'S, Newfoundland, April 20.—Although local weather conditions were favorable, two storms were reported today working westward from mid-Atlantic, and for this reason Harry G. Hawker, Australian airman, and Captain Frederick Raynham, Britisher, decided not to start on their trans-Atlantic flight.
