Workers Demand Collective Bargaining on Big Scale.

STRIKE PHASES REVIEWED

Troubles at Winnipeg Declared Incident to Fight for New Industrial Order.

TORONTO, June 4.—The industrial conflict now being waged in Canada is undoubtedly the most serious since the war, taking on more and more the characteristics of class war.

That this development should have first taken place in the ultra-democratic west, where, if anywhere, all men are free and equal, is all the more striking.

One of the outstanding signs of the efficiency of the Winnipeg citizens' organization was street blocks full of parked motor cars.

The action of the Winnipeg citizens' committee in assuming an attitude of uncompromising hostility to the strikers may have been inevitable.

Observers surprised by strike. The sweeping sentiment in favor of abolition of titles which found formal expression by the vote in Parliament is an indication of the attitude of the nation toward privileges of the past.

War Veterans and Labor Men Hold Rival Processions.

STREET CLASH IS FEARED

Soldiers Promise to "Tear Union Headquarters to Pieces" if Food Supply Is Curtailed.

WINNIPEG, June 4.—Winnipeg, strike-worn for 20 days, today witnessed the most spectacular scenes of rival demonstrations which have taken place since the general walkouts of the union workers May 15.

Returned soldiers who refused to indorse the general strike held their first parade today. Army officers, hundreds of soldiers and some union leaders were in line.

back of the bonds by lending its credit, the securities are good as gold and the eastern Oregon advocates of the measure contend that the interest charges per cent bonds, they can be issued at 4 1/2 or 5 per cent and sell at par.

The enabling act and the reconstruction bond measure are companion pieces of legislation. The enabling act amends the constitution and permits the bonding of the state for \$5,000,000 to be distributed in the building of armories; buildings at Oregon Agricultural college and University of Oregon, each to cost \$500,000; Monument Normal \$100,000; a new penitentiary \$500,000; a new building for the state hospital at Pendleton, \$150,000; the settlement of land, \$447,500, and the erection of small buildings at diverse state institutions.
