

PRICES BEING STEADIED

AUTHORITY TO REGULATE BY LICENSE GRANTED.

Tremendous Gain in Grain Stocks on Hand Shown by Food Department Bulletin.

NEW YORK, June 25.—Julius Barnes, United States wheat director, made public tonight a proclamation by President Wilson granting him full authority to regulate by license the exportation and importation of wheat and wheat flour for the purposes of stabilizing prices.

Stocks of wheat in country elevators, mills and terminal elevators on June 13 totalled 4,013,000 bushels, as compared with 18,599,000 on the same date a year ago, according to a bulletin issued tonight by the food administration which has transferred the functions delegated to him.

Flour products the week ending June 13 amounted to 1,137,000 barrels, against 1,920,000 barrels the previous week and 1,411,000 barrels a year ago, making a total production of flour from July 1, 1918, to June 13, 1919, of 117,935,000 barrels.

The company will erect three 20,000-gallon tanks for the storage of gasoline, coal oil and distillate, and will also have a warehouse to house the pumps, trucks and other equipment.
