# PRICES BEING STEADIED

AUTHORITY TO REGULATE BY LICENSE GRANTED.

Tremendous Gain in Grain Stocks on Hand Shown by Food Department Bulletin.

NEW YORK, June 25 .- Julius Barnes, United States wheat director, made public tonight a proclamation by President Wilson granting him full authority to regulate by license the exportation and importation of wheat wheat flour for the purposes of stabillaing prices.

Mr. Barnes said that the regulations he would put into effect were similar to those which have been enorrced by the war trade board, which heretofore has exercised the functions delegated to him.

Stocks of wheat in country elevators, mills and terminal elevators on June 12 totalled 49,983,990 bushels, as compared with 18,599,000 on the same date a year ago, according to a bulletin ismed tonight by the food administration grain corporation. This was a decrease from the preceding week of 5,640,000 bushels. Receipts from farms for the week ending June 13 were 2,200,000 bushels, as compared with

2.081,000 the previous week. Flour products the week ending June amounted to 1,197,000 barrels. against 1,923,000 barrels the previous week and 1.411,000 barrels a year ago, making a total production of flour from July 1, 1918, to June 13, 1919, of 117, 935,000 barrels.
