REVOLUTION ON IN PERU

TRIO OF PRESIDENTS FIGURE IN MORNING COUP.

Washington Has No Confirmation of Opera Bouffe Revolt Staged by Disappointed Claimant.

LIMA, Peru, July 4.—A revolution broke out here at 3 o'clock this morning. President Pardo and the members of his cabinet were imprisoned.

General A. A. Caceres, former president, was in charge of the revolutionary coup. Later in the morning he turned over control of affairs to Augusto B. Leguia, the president-elect.

The revolutionary movement was accomplished without bloodshed.

A presidential election was held in Peru last May, the result of which has been in dispute. Augusto B. Leguia, the independent party candidate, claimed his election by a substantial majority.

The claim, however, was disputed by Antonio Aspillaga, candidate of the civil party.

Two regiments of the military and a force of police rushed the palace at 3 o'clock this morning and took President Pardo prisoner. These forces then proclaimed Augusto B. Leguia president of the republic. Only a few shots were exchanged and there were no casualties.

WASHINGTON, D. C., July 4.—No information of a revolutionary outbreak at Lima has been received either by the Peruvian legation or the state department. The legation received several communications today from Lima, and as none made reference to any disturbance legation officials said they strongly doubted that a revolutionary movement had been undertaken.

Requests for additional information concerning the reported outbreak brought no further details and, in fact, court communications today from Peru. Inquiries made in New York, Washington and direct to Peru brought forth nothing but indication that the Lima dispatch was exaggerated.

OTHER BRUTES GET SEPARATE TRIALS

In cases where enemies have committed offenses affecting two or more of the allies they will be brought before the joint military court, which will probably sit in London. Before these international courts will be brought before it the Hun's responsibility for the wanton destruction of Louvain will be brought before the Belgian military court. Besides the officials concerned in the deportations from Lille will be brought before the French court in Paris. The U-boat commanders who sank the British hospital ships will be tried by the British court in London. These courts may exact the death penalty.
