

CENTER OF STRIKE MOVES TO CAPITAL

Senate Committee to Open Hearings Today.

BIG QUESTION AT ISSUE

Evidence Gathered to Show Russian Money Used to Create Unrest in America.

Senate of the Kaiser's government, who possesses apparently unlimited funds. He has been known to communicate with people in this country since the armistice and the men with whom he has been in communication are identified as the most radical elements in New York and Philadelphia. There are also many indications that those who sympathized with Germany during the war, but who remained passive and inactive during the time and means to the spread of industrial unrest.

That Ludwig A. C. Martens, styled "ambassador of the Russian federalized soviet republic," is in communication with Moscow, is an open secret. That appeals to the "American working class" from "congresses" of "Russian workmen" in this country resemble the "appeals" which he has made to the United States government is a matter of common knowledge to those who have been investigating "red" activities.

Russians Reported Involved.

One question, however, which has never been answered is how he can maintain a daily deposit of between \$5000 and \$6000 in a New York bank, checking the money out in great quantities, but always making new deposits. Where does this money come from? What is it being used for? To the activities of the Russian soviet representatives in the United States have any relationship to the industrial unrest? Why are the Russians so active in this country? Why should they be taking part in the steel strike in Pittsburgh and Chicago?

These questions the nation looks upon the senate committee to answer by its investigation because if the committee goes to the bottom of this steel strike it will find scores of Russians have been active as any other foreigners.

There is still another angle to the steel strike and the nation-wide agitation for a general strike, which may interest the senate. In the United States today from New York to Seattle there are close to 250 radical newspapers and magazines advocating the general strikes, which to them are but dress rehearsals for the revolution.

Surely the facts which have been discovered in Pittsburgh before and during the strike suggest a sufficient background for the senate to serve as a beginning for its questioning of the radical labor leaders.

"The time has come," he said, "when the public must be educated to the real menace which confronts the United States. Nothing will be done in Washington until the country demands it. At present there seems to be a conspiracy to hush it up but while the public is silent, the 'reds' prepare."

"For months now the revolutionists have been working on a programme for a general strike. Each time they gain by experience and their strength increases. They began in Seattle in February. By May their plans for a general strike had spread to scores of cities and they made attempts in Detroit and Cleveland. The next date they selected was July 6, then September 1. The steel strike they regarded only as a test of national strength. They are talking now of a great strike on January 1 and in their private meetings they discuss the possibilities of a real revolution."

"While they plan, organize, prepare and agitate, the great majority of people go on with their own work and pay no attention to their sinister schemes. It is time for the nation to unite and fight. If the great majority of people do not unite now, they may find some of these morning that the radicals have succeeded in bringing about a general strike when they are powerless."

The issue and the opportunity is tonight before the senate committee. Within 48 hours the country will know how "far" the senate will go.

HUNS MUST QUIT BALTIC

ALLIES WILL STOP GERMANY'S FOOD UNTIL OBEYED.

Mere Recall of Von der Goltz Will Not Suffice—Slowness Causes Great Disorder.

PARIS, Sept. 30.—(By the Associated Press.)—Germany's recall of General von der Goltz from the Baltic region will not satisfy the supreme council, it is asserted by the council being determined to place economic pressure on Germany until all the German soldiers are withdrawn.

The German soldiers in this region are estimated at from 50,000 to 100,000. They apparently are determined to restore the old Russian regime there.

Members of the peace delegation repeatedly have conferred with Baron Kurt von Lersner, head of the German mission, concerning Von der Goltz and his forces, and the German government had agreed to remove them. The slowness in action, however, has resulted in great disorder in the Baltic states.

While it cannot be said that a blockade is actually on against Germany, steps are being taken to bring about financial pressure which will speedily cut off the German food supply. Food now on the way to Germany will not be stopped but future supplies will be held up unless the German government makes good its promise to evacuate the troops.

Obituary.

J. M. Carpenter, well known on the Pacific coast as a lumberman, died at his home in Cherry Grove, Or., on Sunday, September 28. He was in his 78th year.

Mr. Carpenter was closely identified with lumber interests in New York, Pennsylvania and Oregon and was with the Pacific Coast Lumber company in Los Angeles for a number of years. Interment will be made in Los Angeles by the Masonic order, of which Mr. Carpenter was a member.

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ALBANY, Or., Sept. 30.—(Special.)—Mrs. E. J. Barrows, one of Albany's best-known women in the pioneer days of the city and wife of one of Albany's first business men, died Sunday at her home in Oakland, Cal., according to word received by M. J. Monteth, her nephew. The body will be sent to Albany for burial. Mrs. Barrows, who was 81 years old, came to Linn county in 1852 and resided here for many years. She was a sister of Mrs. Margaret A. Monteth of this city, wife of the late Walter Monteth, who, with his brother, Thomas Monteth, founded the original townsite of Albany.

OREGON CITY, Or., Sept. 30.—(Special.)—Harold R. Brown, son of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Brown, died at the family residence at Clackamas Heights Monday after a brief illness. The child was born January 24, 1913. The funeral services will be held from the chapel of Holman & Pace tomorrow at 10 o'clock, with Rev. W. B. Bean, pastor of the Christian church, officiating. Interment will be in Clackamas cemetery.

WOMAN'S POSITION SHAKY

MRS. PRINGLE SUBJECT TO REMOVAL, IS OPINION.

District Attorney Evans Holds Lack of Citizenship Bar to Holding of Office.

Mrs. Mary E. Pringle, a probation officer whose appointment by Judge Evans of the court of domestic relations was approved Monday by the county commissioners, holds her position illegally and can be removed summarily on the constitutional grounds that she is not a citizen of the United States.

This was the decision of District Attorney Evans yesterday after further investigation of the question presented to him last week when the fact that Mrs. Pringle was not naturalized became known.

Mr. Evans said he believed the question was settled by section eight, article six of the constitution of Oregon which reads as follows: "No person shall be elected or appointed to a county office who shall not be an elector of the county."

Authority has been given Mrs. Pringle to arrest persons, under a deputy sheriff's commission, and as a county officer she is thought by Mr. Evans to come clearly under the provisions of the constitutional prohibition.

Mrs. Pringle has a husband living in Scotland who is a bar to her naturalization in this country.

Mrs. Pringle, whose appointment followed the dismissal of Mrs. Della C. Whiting, chief probation officer, was chosen by Judge Kanier after being passed, as very well qualified for the post by the child welfare commission and personally recommended by Mrs. Millie R. Trumbull, secretary of the commission.

A pair of shoes sold by a manufacturer for \$5.50 was displayed in a Boston store 400 yards from the factory, and marked \$12.
