DIKING WORK IS RUSHED

Project in Columbia Near St. Helens is Progressing.
ST. HELENS, Or., Oct. 7.—(Special)—The work of diking the overflow and lowlands between the Columbia river and the highland of the Washington shore is progressing rapidly. Two dredges are digging a channel nine miles long and throwing up an embankment or dike which is 60 feet at the bottom and 24 feet at the top. It is estimated that 9000 acres of land which are covered by the high water each year will be reclaimed and the land reclaimed will provide hundreds of fruit and truck farms. The cost of the project is around \$350,000. The work is being handled by the Columbia river diking district No. 5.

JAPANESE BARON IS DUE
