

ONE-WAY TRAFFIC PLANNED FOR CITY Solution of Downtown Congestion in Prospect.

MAYOR APPROVES PLAN

Ordinance to Be Introduced Naming Streets for Exclusive Movement—System Used in East.

Inauguration of a partial plan for one-way traffic in the congested district of Portland is offered by Mayor Baker and Captain Lewis, in charge of the traffic department of the police bureau, as the only possible solution of the congested condition of the business district.

Under the proposed plan Morrison, Washington, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth and Broadway streets will continue to serve for traffic going two ways.

Streets on which northbound traffic only would be permitted are Front, Second and Park streets. Southbound traffic would be routed over First and West Park streets.

One-Way Traffic in View. To carry out the proposed plan Captain Lewis will recommend that the Rose City Park and Beaumont streets be routed north on Second street.

The eventual plan offered by Captain Lewis will include the looping of all street cars operated in the congested district and will mean one-way traffic for all streets in the city.

Mayor Approves Plan. The plan offered by Captain Lewis for handling of traffic in the congested district meets with my hearty approval, said Mayor Baker.

One-way traffic is the only solution. It is no experiment, as it has been successful in other cities.

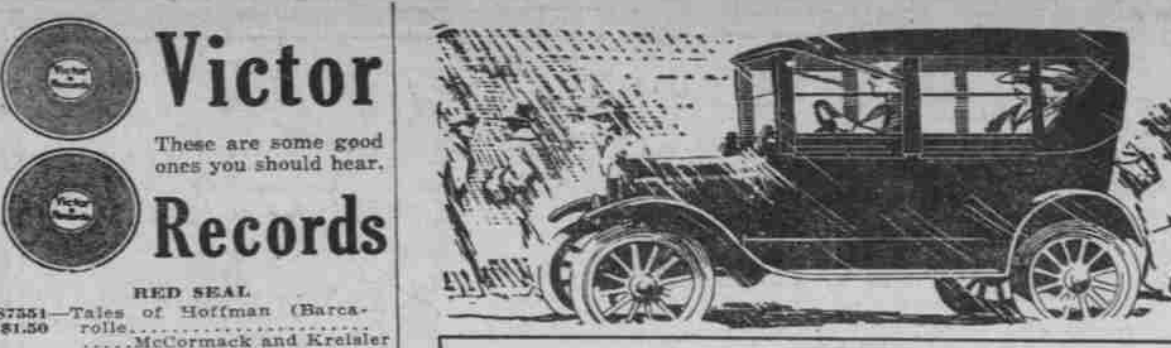
