Three Hundred Dine With French Friends.

WALLACE MAKES ADDRESS

Ambassador Lauds Part Played in Winning War—Gratitude Expressed to Ally.

PARIS, Nov. 26.—Three hundred Americans celebrated Thanksgiving this evening at the Hotel Quai d'Orsay, some of their distinguished French friends joining them.

Hugh F. Wallace, American ambassador, said: "This, perhaps, each of the allied and associated powers might feel entitled to say a word in behalf of itself in regard to the victory.

"We were grateful to France, which sustained the cause of liberty in the world and throughout the world.
