Jackson Club Slate Overcomes Opposition.

ELTON WATKINS CHOSEN

"Hand-Picked Bunch" Is Term Applied by W. T. Vaughn to Chamberlain Gathering.

"It's a hand-picked bunch," blurted W. T. Vaughn, as he tried to talk until the lights went out at the central library Monday night, when the Jackson club was in the throes of electing a president.

It appears that the Jackson club was considered an important objective in the coming political campaign, and all the federal brigades, with the possible exception of the postmaster, was on the job to attain the objective.

Up leaped Mr. Vaughn, prepared to make a nominating speech, but having no one in mind. He talked unlimbered about the quality of his friend, Elton Watkins, and then wound up by asserting he could not support him because he is a servant of the federal bunch.

Election Is Declared. Tiring of the Vaughn verbiage, the worried federalists again declared Mr. Watkins elected. Miss Gavin of the Dalles was nominated for one of the vice-presidents.
