that Mahan was called as a witness, "in view of the testimony of the defendant that Lieutenant Mahan and not himself was responsible for bru-tal treatment of prisoners." Mahan testified that American sol-

diers divided stolen property among themselves while serving in the de-partment of criminal investigation at aris, to which he was attached before being assigned to assist Detzer.
