

RODEO WITNESSES DETZER

LIEUTENANT IS WITNESS AT COURT-MARTIAL. Maltreatment of Soldiers at Le Mans Prison Camp Admitted by Subordinate.

NEW YORK, Jan. 14.—Testimony that Captain Karl W. Detzer maltreated soldiers at the prison camp at Le Mans, of which he was in charge, was given at his court-martial today by Lieutenant Leonard D. Mahan, who served under him. Mahan told of finding prisoners with their noses against a mark on the wall, "to think over what happened to other men."

Major William P. Kelley announced that Mahan was called as a witness, "in view of the relations of the defendant to Lieutenant Mahan and not himself was responsible for brutal treatment of prisoners."

Mahan testified that American soldiers divided stolen property among themselves while serving in the department of critical investigation at Paris, to which he was attached before being assigned to assist Detzer.
