San Francisco Gasoline Prices Higher

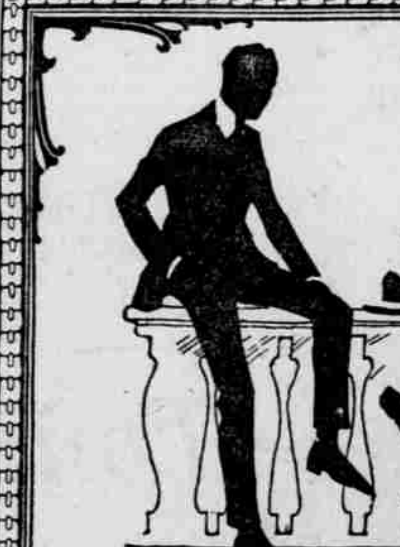

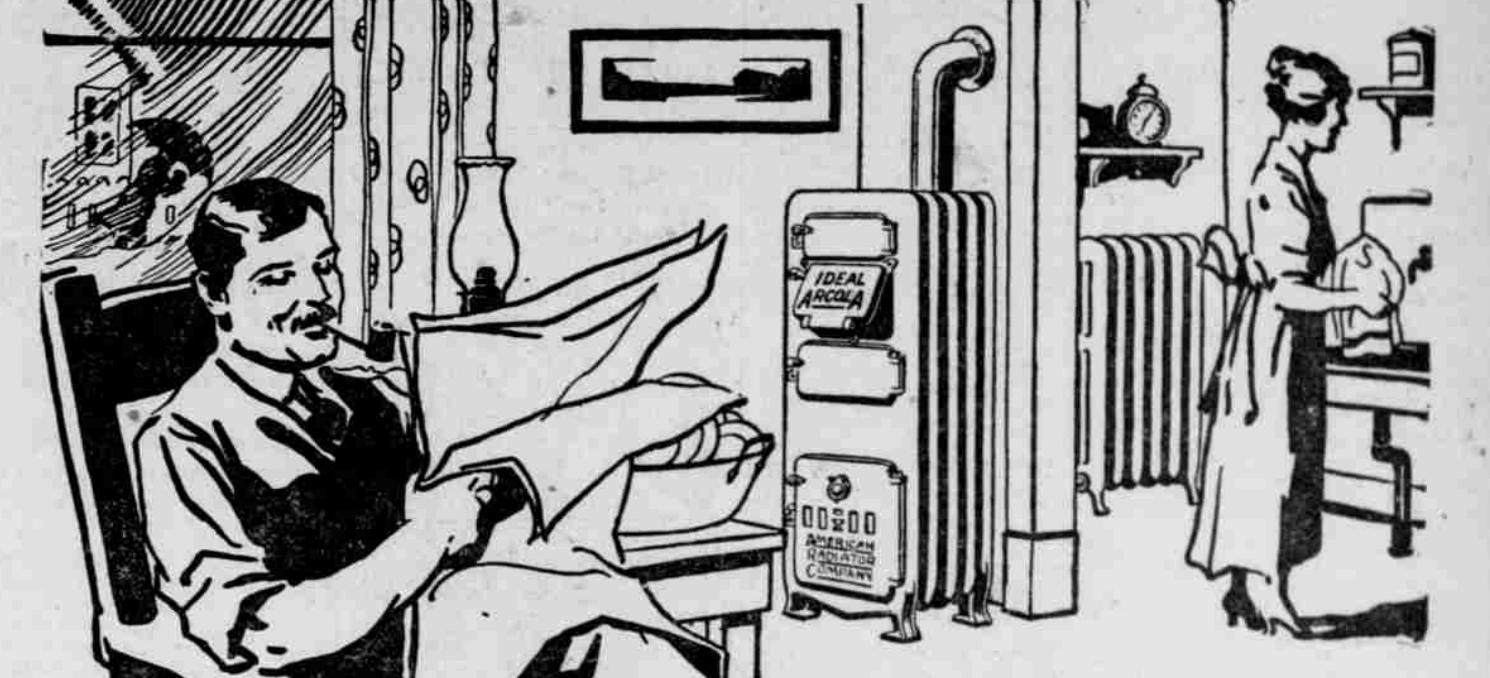
