## Socialists Resent Coalition.

"A change of government equivalent to a change of system has, to be sure, not been achieved. New men have come, but the old system remains. The independent socialist

remains. The independent socialist party cannot and will not enter such a coalition government. It will enter-tain only a purely socialistic govern-ment. We demand a purely socialistic government. Let there be no lei up in revolutionary energy. The danger of a military counter-revolution is not yet overcome. A coalition government is important to banish this danger. 'A general strike cannot be carried on long. We must be prepared to employ the general strike again, but only when the circumstances demand and when success appears probable.
