

WAR OVER FISH AND GAME NEARS CLOSE

End of Controversy Within Month Expected.

NEW ADJUSTMENT IS MADE

Complete Segregation of Commercial and Game Interests Effected at Commission Meeting.

RESULTS OF FISH AND GAME COMMISSION'S SESSION

The department ordered moved to Gasco building. Resignation of State Game Warden Carl D. Shoemaker tendered yesterday. Stanley Jewett appointed executive secretary of fish commission. Resolution designed to bring about settlement of fish war in southern Oregon considered. Several thousand dollars appropriated for trout hatcheries.

Complete segregation of the commercial and game interests hitherto handled from one office of the state fish and game commission and the appointment of two new heads of the latter department were accomplished at the meeting of the joint commission yesterday, and probably marks the end of a long controversy between a group of sportsmen and the state game warden.

Mr. Jewett, who for the past year has been in the United States biological survey, was given over to discussion of the Rogue river fish controversy and a settlement of the same was expected within a month. An agreement submitted by various interests on the river suggesting changes in the length of season and the method of fishing did not meet with entire approval and the attorney-general, Wallace, was called in to mediate.

Other important business that was put through during the day includes appropriations for the development of trout hatcheries.

With the divorce of the commercial and game department on May 1, Mr. Jewett will move his office to the new quarters in the Gasco building, while Captain Burghdoff and Mr. Jewett will remain in the rooms now occupied in the Oregon building. Mr. Jewett's duties will include direction of the patrol service for the commercial fish and game, and the commercial fishing licenses and conduct of hearings. Associated with him will be E. C. Hensley, who will continue as meter fish warden, and for the time being, have charge of all trout operations for the game commission and be in charge of all salmon hatcheries.

The new game warden was elected at the present salary of \$3,000 and a similar amount will be paid the executive secretary of the fish commission, Captain Burghdoff, for his services as game warden. Captain Jewett, previous to his army enlistment, he spent a year and half overseas with the signal corps. He had made Portland his home since 1902.

Mr. Jewett Well Known.

Mr. Jewett is perhaps better known outside of Portland than the city as he has lived in the state 18 years, spending ten years of that time with the United States biological survey. For six years he was engaged in scientific research work. He is regarded as one of the best posted men in the northwestern part of the life of Oregon.

Chairman E. V. Carter, who presides over the commission, presented the matter of the over-fishing of the Rogue river, and Commissioner Frank M. Warren read the suggested agreement signed by the Rogue River Fish and Game Association, the Ashland Fish and Game Association, the Oregon Chapter of Commerce, the Ashland Chamber of Commerce, the Oregon Hotel Men's association and Frederick Macleay, a cannery operator at Wedderburn.

Dr. Willis H. Rich of the United States bureau of fisheries agreed with Mr. Clanton that the proposed compromise would not in the end offer much relief to sportsmen. Commissioner Warren pointed out that legislation of the kind proposed in the document would be ruinous and quite as foolish to try on the Rogue river as on the Columbia.

"Macley is willing to forego the use of seines and set nets," he said, "but that doesn't fortify against cleaning out the river by making the season longer."

A motion proposed by Mr. Warren and seconded by Commissioner Stone was counted means to define the commission's legal rights and settle the controversy. "I think it will be off our hands within a month," declared Mr. Warren at the close of the meeting.

The resolution introduced follows: "Resolved, That it is the sense of the joint meeting of the fish and game commissions that they heartily approve the efforts which have been made to secure a compromise of the Rogue river situation and thereby eliminate the contentions which have been a source of so great controversy as to be detrimental to both the sportsmen and commercial interests of that locality; that the commission will endeavor in every way possible to assist in bringing this matter to a satisfactory conclusion, and with that object in view authorize the transmission of a copy of the suggested agreement to the commission of the bureau of fisheries for an expression of opinion from that department as to its views in the matter of commercial fishing seasons and any other points which may be of interest to them."

It also authorizes the calling of hearings to be held as soon as possible at Medford and at Gold Beach for
