

LOCAL CURTAINS TO ADD 200 PAIRES TO FLEET \$50,000 Station Included in Development Plans. NEW ROUTES ARE ADDED

A \$50,000 station and equipment conveniences will be built in the immediate future by the Oregon-Washington & Idaho Aeroplane company on its aviation fleet at Quilley's lake.

Such was the decision of the executive committee of the board of directors at a session held in the office of Julius L. Meler, president of the company, yesterday afternoon.

Victor Vernon was elected as manager of the company and O. K. Jeffery as assistant manager. Branch offices will be established all over the three northwestern states.

The company now has a fleet of eight Curtiss ships on its field at Quilley's lake, making regular flights over the city, and Mr. Vernon announced yesterday that beginning at once, 14 planes will soar above the business section of Portland every day at 12 o'clock, no matter what the weather conditions are.

"We want to invite to the people of this city and others who may be visitors here that our planes are reliable and can fly in any kind of weather and are a dependable conveyance," said Mr. Vernon.

Seaside to be terminal point on this trip and as there is no adequate landing place on the beach it is the intention to align in the Necanicum river, the sea gull Curtiss type of plane being used.

Manager Vernon has had seven years of successful work with the Curtiss planes in the United States, and during the latter part of 1918 he was chief instructor at Lake Charles, continuing in this capacity until 1919, when he received a commission as lieutenant colonel in the naval reserve, doing experimental and test duty.

After his retirement from the naval service, he rejoined the Curtiss organization and had charge of all of its flying operations. In November, 1919, he was sent to Portland to establish a branch agency and became convinced that the northwest coast has such a great future in this line of transportation that he decided to join the local company.

Mr. Vernon said he expects the company will sell not less than 30 planes this season.
