

GRAIN BAG PRICES

Market Holds in Line With Strength at Calcutta.

SHIPPING BACKWARD

Quantity Purchased for This Coast Will Probably Be Sufficient for All Requirements.

Buying of bags by dealers has been lighter this week owing to the slow demand from farmers, but prices remain very firm.

The latest Calcutta cables report 53,000-590 bags bought to date. Shipments from Calcutta to the end of March were 10,750-900 bags, so there will be a heavy movement in April and the first half of May to get the bags to the coast in time.

The Calcutta is now loading a rail cargo at Calcutta for San Francisco and it is believed there will be enough tonnage available for the remaining shipping season.

Before the war the Pacific coast requirements averaged about 50,000,000 bags annually. Increase in bulk handling of grain has cut down the bag needs somewhat.

The price of grain bags is made in Calcutta, not here, and Calcutta advice does not show any signs of a weakening market.

Eastern Bulk Oats and Barley Are Not Quoted on Local Board.

The Merchants' Exchange association decided yesterday not to call for bids on eastern clipped oats and eastern bulk barley until market conditions change.

The markets were soft firm. May corn bids were raised 50 cents and blue feed barley were 50¢ higher.

Patents Are 30 to 70 Cents Higher—East Is Stronger.

Flour prices have gone up sharply since the time the Minneapolis market advanced 30 to 70 cents per barrel.

The Kansas-Oklahoma hard winter wheat mills report a four percent increase in production at several of the terminals.
