SENATOR'S DEFEAT AIM... Supporters of Hoover, Lowden and Poindexter Urged to Throw Strength to General.

Renewed warnings that any effort in behalf of Hoover, Lowden or Poindexter among the republicans of Oregon would only serve the purpose of Wood.
